I was completely dumbfounded why this happened since I held my course and speed. On other canal crossings Teresa and I had made with other cruisers, once the pilot was transferred, the pilot boat merely eased the throttle and peeled off. Preston explained to me that even though our pilot helmsman's move was inappropriate for our size of vessel what he did was standard for leaving a ship. That procedure is very similar to leaving a dock when the wind has you pinned. Leaving the dock involves turning the bow into the dock so that the stern

will kick out so you may back away. Of course when leaving the dock you employ a spring line and a fender. Preston went on to explain that when a pilot boat is next to a moving ship he can't just peel off because the suction of the ship moving through the water will keep the pilot boat against the ship just as the wind can hold you against a dock. I still don't excuse the pilot boat's helmsman action that day, but at least with Preston's explanation I understand what he was trying to do.

Congratulations to Preston Lewis and Jack Sterrett on receiving their Seamanship, Piloting, and Advance Piloting. Now guys, how about a couple of the elective courses?

I hope to see you all at our next membership meeing Saturday, February 23.

From both Georgia and South Carolina sources, the most often noted offenses committed by boaters were 1) Missing PFD's 2) Documents missing or improper marking (missing numbers and decals) 3) Drunk Driving 4) Missing or out-ofdate visual distress signals 5) Fire extinguisher violations 6) Inoperable sound producing device 7) Missing navigation lights 8)Pollution placard violations 9) Negligent operation; 10)Dirty or no backflame arrester. All except items (3) and (9) can be avoided by a visit from your friendly VSC. Please add Preston Lewis to your list of VSC examiners.


