We're very pleased to report that I4 folks attended our last ABC class, and we could have had more if there had been a larger space. The University of Georgia Extension building allows us to hold our classes in their classroom and we're very appreciative of that. They have placed a limit on the number of occupants in the classroom to maintain proper social distancing and we are careful to abide by the guidelines. The next ABC class is Feb 6 and we already have two students enrolled. The other two ABC classes scheduled for 2021 are April 3 and October 9.

The Marine Navigation course will be held in the evenings beginning on January II and we'll use a ZOOM platform to deliver instruction. The full schedule is as follows: January II, January I8, January 25, February I, and February 8. In addition, there will be two face-to-face meetings held at the UGA facility.

Those will be the practicums and they will be on January 23 and January 30. Each of the practicums will be held from 9:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m. The written materials are all on-line and provided at nocost. Each student will need a laptop computer (Mac or PC) capable of running OpenCPN software. You will also need a USPS plotter and a set of dividers and we will do a group purchase for those interested.

Commander Charles is the primary instructor, and he will have some lab assistants to help with the practicums to give you personal attention with plotting instruction. Please let Charles or me know via email if you want to take the class and we'll get in contact with you with class times and to get order information.




